FPEIM presentation to Provincial Government – Mar 13 –highlights distributed

The **Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) 72nd Annual Conference** will be held in Whistler, British Columbia June 5-8, 2009. The FCM Annual General meeting will be held during the conference on Sunday, June 7th from 10:00 –11:45, which will be followed by the election of FCM's National Board of Directors from 12:30 to 14:00. Received the **Ground Water Testing and Sampling** Report from the fall of 2008 on March 24. Briefly – 17 wells were sampled – 1 exceeded iron criteria for drinking water, 7 exceeded manganese (2 by more than 100 times). All other metals were within the drinking water guidelines. Analytical chemistry tests found all within guidelines except one for chloride (criteria was 250 mg/L , sample was 306 mg/L).

Two wells (MW 5 and 10) were tested more extensively - VOCs and PCBs and were at non-detectable levels, as were dioxins and furans. Samples varied somewhat from previous years, but were in same range as previous sample sets. Kevin Curley, who delivered the report noted that the first batch of private wells all came back clean, and expects results for the other wells soon.
