**Call to Order:**

Council Chair Don Aitken called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. and turned the meeting over to Returning Officer John Berry.

**Position of Chair:**

After asking for further nominations three times, and receiving none, the Returning Officer declared the nominations closed for the positions of Councillor of Miltonvale Park.

Candidates were allotted time to introduce themselves to the residents. Voters were instructed to place an “X” in the square beside the names of up to six candidates on the ballot. The election for Councillors was held by secret ballot.
