

Water and Sewer Committee Report for 2008

The Water and Sewer Committee is pleased to report that the Wastewater and Water Servicing Feasibility Report started in 2008 will soon be complete.

Engineering Technologies Canada (E.T.C.), the chosen firm of the Request for Proposal process, partnered with TerrAtlantic (Fredericton, N.B.) and MacDonald Harland Engineering (Charlottetown, P.E.) to complete this study. This project has received funding through the Canada – Prince Edward Island New Deal for Cities and Communities – Community Capacity Building Fund which is managed by the Prince Edward Island Department of Communities, Cultural Affairs and Labour.

A survey of the community was completed and with this and other information gathered by E.T.C. a community meeting was hosted in early October to bring residents up to date with the progress of the report. This was a well attended meeting and residents took part with many questions for those presenting.

The Sewer and Water committee (which also includes Councillor Betty Pryor, and resident Don Aitken) meets with Ms. Kelly Galloway (E.T.C.) at different times to hear how the project is progressing.

With the data and information collected, and the final report soon to be completed, the community will have much needed information to prepare a strategy to go forward with sewer and water development for the Community of Miltonvale Park. There will be a community meeting to review the recommendations of this report.
